

## History of Hollington

In 1893 A H Gilkes the then Master of Dulwich College opened the Dulwich College Mission. The Centre was originally for the benefit of boys in Camberwell, a notoriously deprived area of London at that time. Later the Mission took over the Hollington Youth Centre; we have continued to support the community and local young people of Camberwell ever since.

We are immensely fortunate to have a great team of workers and volunteers, but the pressure remains to improve the resources available to support them.

The Centre needs to build on creating other sources of revenue by encouraging members of the local community to use our facilities. The income generated from the community using our facilities will allow us to work with more young people and families.

## Sports Hall

- We have the floor markings for badminton, tennis, football and basketball
- It can be laid out in a variety of ways including access to chairs and tables

- Use of a projector



## Small Meeting Rooms

We have 2 rooms available.

These rooms are light and airy, ideally suited for business meetings, presentations and training sessions.

### Specs

- The rooms are laid out with a large table that can seat up 8-10 people and has a wall mounted whiteboard

## Open Area

The Open area is an inviting, adaptable space which can be set out with rows, tables or exhibition space according to your needs. Your event can be complimented with refreshments or use of the small meeting rooms as break out spaces, direct access to kitchenette including a serving hatch.

### Specs

- Suitable for up to 60 people seated, 80 Standing

## Boxing Gym

Our recently refurbished boxing gym now boast a 14ft Ring, punch bags, cross trainer and cycle machines as well as showers and changing rooms.
